We invite you to submit your full-length conference paper for an edited book tentatively titled, *Education for Sustainable Social and Economic Progress*. We are only accepting manuscripts that are based on proposals that were accepted for presentation at the fourth World Conference on Transformative Education in Cape Town, South Africa on July 2-4, 2025. In preparing your manuscript, make good use of the feedback you received from us before and during the conference.

Submission Guidelines

- Prospective contributors are invited to submit an abstract of 300 words, a complete manuscript of 6000 to 7000 words (references included), and bio-sketch of 300 words for each author by September 20, 2025
- The manuscript must be double-spaced, 12-point font size, Times Roman, and it must follow the 7th edition of APA Style.
- All manuscripts will undergo a double-blind peer review process and decisions should be expected by November 20, 2025.
- Only manuscripts submitted in English will be considered for this volume. Carefully proofread your manuscript prior to submission.
- The book will be published in 2026 by a publisher to be announced after the 2025 conference.
- To ease the blind review process, submit two files:
 1. Title page with the title of the manuscript, names and institutional affiliation of the author(s), and a 50-word bio-sketch for each author.
 2. Manuscript—title, abstract (300 words), and full-length paper (6000 to 7000)
